Bill - Opening

- October Meeting- Jose's—This in-person meeting will be fun and include dinner for Board members.
- 60th Anniversary "6 for 60"—As a special courtesy of the club, a raffle will be featured where the winner receives a gift valued at \$60. This idea was approved by the Executive Board.
- Executive Board election Slipstream notice: update ONLINE voting—The election ballot will be printed in Slipstream. The online voting initiative approved by the board is in development with plans to include it with voting during the Founder's Day People's Choice Concours.
- Chris-Financial and Slipstream payment update—The club received a quarterly rebate of \$15.50 per new and returning member. Historically, these receipts equaled about \$8,459 in 2020 and \$9,381 in 2021. For this quarter, the quarterly rebate was \$10, 494. Overall, the club's current balance of \$154, 321 reflects a slight change over prior month's balance of \$156, 822. This difference of about \$2,500 reflects both receipts and expenses for the month. Details are included in the included summary report.
- Dana &Susie- Advertising update—There is no change from prior month with 95% advertising revenue collected. Despite follow-up with two outstanding accounts (Mullineaux?
