- Event cancelations any changes—The status of member cancellations for events was reviewed. Overall, there is no change with attrition estimated at 25-30% For example, the recent Tech Session received registrations of 66 but attendance of about 40. On the other hand, Doug Jacobsen mentioned that the Tyler event showed 100% attendance with 70 registered.
- Executive Board election notice and online voting—December 10, 2022
- Chair changes and update with M&M—Matt Wilson is retiring from serving as Chair. Mike McHorse assumes this role with Rishi Burke and John Collier as co-chairs.
- Landon- Mav of the Month; Amazon gift card courtesy of Autobahn—David Hodges, long-time club racing chair, is the Mav of the Month. A December race has been added. The recent after party was a lot of fun with Chris, Bill, Carey, and Racers in attendance.
- Carey- From the Regions -Jack Griffin and ML Speer will be featured in Panorama. The Fredericksburg unpaved tour included an 80-mile tour, good weather and 10 cars (versus 14 registered). The idea of a Spring 2023 joint region tour has been proposed for the Maverick Region and Hill Country Regions. It is possible that Lone Star and Longhorn Regions may also be included. The proposed timeframe is April or May 2023. The Maverick Region achieved a ranking of 3<sup>rd</sup> highest in membership behind Upper Canada and Potomac Regions in first and second place.
