
## **ROADS App Writeup**


## Section 1: Setup and use

1. Download the app on your phone.


OR go to the App Store (or Google Play) and search for Roads By Porsche




2. Sign in to the app using either your porsche ld or any email you prefer. If you don't have one, you can sign up for the porsche id.




3. Once logged in, click on the community in the lower right section



In case of Android App, instead of communities you will see a section called Groups,




4. Search for Mavs PCA




5. Click the group name and press join. This will now show up in your community (Groups in case of Android) section



6. Click on the community (Groups in case of Android) again and look for MAVS PCA in the groups. Click it.




7. Once inside, click on the routes logo on the top right corne






8. Click on any one of the routes and press "Drive this road now."



9. This will start your navigation mode. After the warning notification, Please sect the option: "Road starting point" this will make sure you navigate from the beginning of the route.



10. Just follow the route! If you have CarPlay, this will come up in the CarPlay display.

It's recommended that you start at the starting point of the route. If not, it will navigate you to the starting point.



If you are connected to Apple CarPlay, then the maps will display on the car PCM. If not, it will continue to show just like Apple Maps or Google Maps. Do not use ROADS to get to the starting point. It works for that purpose, but what it will do is get you on the route on priority, so depending on where the starting point is, it may or may not be skipped. The best is to use your regular maps app. Roads will reroute if you take a wrong turn. The turn-by-turn is as good as Apple Maps.

Roads do not have the capability for speed limits and traffic. Keep that in consideration. If there is a road closure, you will need to follow the detour, and it will get you back on. Once it's back on the main road, ROADS will take over and move you ahead.
